

***Disabled Riders
Added to Illinois'***

**Seniors
Ride Free
Program**

Additional changes in Illinois law provide free rides, for disabled persons who qualify for the Illinois Circuit Breaker Program, on all Illinois public transit system regular fixed route buses. The local date for implementation of this new law is October 20, 2008.

The State of Illinois will be mailing postcards to eligible participants of the Circuit Breaker Program. The postcards can be used as identification for free rides on B-NPTS fixed route buses. Just show the postcard to the driver.

If you already have a B-NPTS Elderly/Disabled Free Ride ID card you need not take any further action. Just continue to use your B-NPTS Free Ride ID when boarding the bus.
